Philosophy of the Program

Graceful Beginnings Pre-Kindergarten is a church-based preschool for children ages 3-5 to prepare them to enter kindergarten. We do this through activities that foster self-help social skills. skills independence, academics, spiritual life, learning readiness, language, creativity, and motor development. we believe that preschool children learn best through experiencing and manipulating materials, so our curriculum is very child-centered and Students will be actively hands-on. engaged in activities to teach letters, numbers, colors, shapes, basic reading skills, and name recognition through the use of centers and manipulatives.
